



Step 1: Open the Play Store.




Step 2: Look for the Moodle App.




Step 3: Install the Moodle App.**Step 4:** Tap on Open.

Step 5: Tab on Allow.




Step 6: Enter the following address: *learn.frederick.ac.cy* under Your site and tap on Connect to your site.
